Note 1: Work Method Statement / Traffic Management Plan or Proposal

Where it is proposed to locate a hoarding/scaffolding / other structure on a public road a Work Method Statement / Traffic Management Plan or proposal for management of same, which includes the following, must be submitted:

- Proposed arrangements to ensure minimum impact on traffic flow.
- Arrangements for site deliveries, including time of day restrictions, vehicle queuing arrangements etc.
- Provision for storage of materials etc.

Note 2: Pedestrian Management Plan/Proposal

Where it is proposed to place a hoarding/ scaffolding/other structure on a public road or footpath which will interfere with pedestrian movement a Pedestrian Management Plan/Proposal, which includes the following, must be submitted:

• Arrangements for Pedestrian Diversions including proposals for temporary footpaths, ramps, signage, fencing etc.

Note 3: Insurance Requirements

The Licensee must provide evidence of Employer's and Public Liability Insurance cover for limits of not less than \leq 13 million and \leq 6.5 million respectively in respect of legal liability for bodily injury or third party property damage claims arising in connection with the activities, the subject of this application, for the duration of the licence period.

These policies <u>must be extended to indemnify Clare County Council</u>. Clare County Council reserves the right to review this limit of indemnity for adequacy. The insurance policy shall be submitted for inspection <u>before</u> the Licence will be issued. The licensee is required to maintain a valid policy for the duration of the licence period.

Under Section 254(9) of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended), it is an offence to erect, construct, place or maintain an appliance, apparatus or structure on, under, over or along any public road without having a licence to do so.

(k) A pipe or an appliance with a pipe attachment for dispensing air or water, not being a pipe or appliance attached to a petrol or oil pump.	€25

PART 2 (a) A cabinet used as part of a wired broadcast relay system by a person licenced under the Wireless Telegraphy (Wired Broadcast Relay Licence) Regulations, 1974.	€125

NOTE: Where a Licence is for a period of less than one year, the fee shall be an amount equal to one-tenth of the fee for one year for each month or part of a month for which the licence is granted.

ADDITIONAL FEES:

If a wind breaker is being provided around tables and chairs, a fee of \le 630 is payable if the barrier contains any text, logo, emblem etc. It is considered to be an advertising structure.
