An application for registration with **Clare County Council** submitted by the producer shall have the following written and signed declarations or attachments enclosed:

- (ii) Adherence to competition law declaration

(iii) Capacity of Producer's National Collection System

In accordance with 9(1) of the Regulations, a producer who places specified vehicles on the market within the state must establish a national system for the collection of specified vehicles, of that producer's brand or for which that producer has responsibility and which that producer anticipates will become end-of-life vehicles in the state.

The Producer must establish a national collection system which shall comprise of authorised treatment facilities where end-of-life vehicles, of that producer's brand or for which that producer

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⁴ An application for registration shall have as attachments written declarations in respect of compliance with the restriction on the use of hazardous substances, adherence to competition law, capacity of the producer's national collection system and annual turnover. In addition, a three-year implementation plan must accompany the application for registration in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 11(2)(b) and Part 3 of Schedule 1 of the Regulations.

has responsibility, may be collected and stored and treated in accordance with the provisions of regulation 15 and Schedule 2 of these Regulations.

Each producer's national collection system must comprise as a minimum, 1 authorised treatment facility per 100,000 persons, with all urban agglomerations of 15,000 persons or more being within 45 kilometres of such a facility. In order to fulfil the requirements of the Regulations, the producer may make arrangements or enter into agreements with the owners or operators of authorised treatment facilities. The arrangements or agreements cannot exceed a period of three years.

(iv) Three year implementation Plan

A three-year implementation plan shall accompany the producer's application for registration. The plan should specify the measures that the producer intends to take in order to comply with the requirements of these Regulations, including in particular the measures which the producer intends to take to ensure the appropriate treatment and recovery of end-of-life vehicles, of that producer's brand or for which that producer has responsibility, in the functional area of Clare County Council. Please refer to document titled - *Three Year Implementation Plan Requirements*

(v) Notice fixed at each ATF that forms a part of a producer's National collection system

Each producer shall furnish each AFT in that producer's national collection system with a notice and require each ATF in that producer's national collection system to fix and maintain in a conspicuous position and be clearly visible to the public the aforementioned notice at or near the main entrance to that ATF. Evidence of these notices is required. The wording for this notice is provided in appendix C - Part 5 of Schedule 1

(vi) Information and promotion - Publish Notices

During the months of March and September in each calendar year, a producer shall publish in one or more newspapers circulating in the functional area of each local authority a notice complying with the requirements of Part 6 of Schedule 1 of the Regulations and provide copies of all notices published, clearly indicating the date and title of the newspaper in which the notice was published, to each local authority within 10 days of the date of publication of each such notice. The wording for this notice is provided in appendix C - Part 6 of Schedule 1

(vii) Promotional literature and Electronic Communication

A producer must publish details of that producer's national collection system -

- (a) in promotional literature, including catalogues and brochures associated with the marketing of new specified vehicles of that producer's brand, and
- (b) on that producers' website and in other electronic means of communication

(viii) Registration Fee

A registration fee must accompany the application for registration to Clare County Council. The prescribed registration fee is as follows -

- (a) €1,000 in respect of a producer whose annual turnover was less than or equal to €50,000,000, or as appropriate,
- (b) €2,500 in respect of a producer whose annual turnover was greater than €50,000,000 but less than or equal to €100,000,000, or as appropriate,
- (c) €6,000 in respect of producers whose annual turnover was greater than €100,000,000.

A producer's annual turnover refers to the preceding twelve-month period or to the projected turnover for the first twelve months of business, if the producer is a new entrant to the market.

A certificate of the producer's annual turnover from an independent person, who is qualified as an auditor, shall accompany the application for registration.

THREE YEAR IMPLEMENTATION PLAN REQUIREMENTS

IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATION 11(2)(b) & PART 3 OF SCHEDULE 1

16.1 GENERAL OVERVIEW

A three-year implementation plan must accompany a producer's application for registration with the

Local Authority. The plan should specify the measures that the producer intends to take in order to

comply with the requirements of S.I. No. 281 of 2014 - European Union (End-of-Life Vehicles)

Regulations 2014 as amended. In particular the measures which the producer intends to take to ensure

the appropriate treatment and recovery of end-of-life vehicles, of that producer's brand or for which

that producer has responsibility, in the functional area of Clare County Council must be detailed.

The three-year implementation plan must also contain the information set out in Part 3 of Schedule 1 of

the above named Regulations. In addition, the producer shall confirm that the plan will be made available

free-of-charge to any person who so requests it in accordance with Regulation 17(3) and 17(4) of the

Regulations.

16.2 INFORMATION & PROMOTION

In accordance with 17(5) of the Regulations, during the months of March and September in each calendar

year, a producer shall publish in one or more newspapers circulating in the functional area of each local

authority a notice complying with the requirements of Part 6 of Schedule 1 of the Regulations and

provide copies of all notices published, clearly indicating the date and title of the newspaper in which

the notice was published, to each local authority within 10 days of the date of publication of each such

notice. The wording for this notice is provided in appendix A
