PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000 (AS AMENDED) PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS 2001 (AS AMENDED) NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT BY A LOCAL AUTHORITY NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

In accordance with Part XI, Section 179 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Part VIII, Articles 80 & 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) notice is hereby given that Clare County Council proposes to carry out the following development:

Nature and Extent of Proposed Development

The proposed works include for the following:

- Change of use from bar and restaurant to community spaces, arts studios, exhibition spaces, tourist information space, and including the retention of existing ground floor café + existing kitchen (over two floors);
- Addition of accessible platform lift internally to make all three floors accessible;
- Addition of a universally accessible toilet and changing places toilet to ground floor;
- Provision of storage internally;
- Stripping out of superficial decoration such as carpets, internal walls and ceiling fittings;
- Creation of 'Art Wall' on ground floor exterior onto Abbey Street in order to facilitate engagement with art in the public realm;
- Internal and external decoration;
- Signage externally;

Location

The Cloister, 49 Abbey Street, Ennis, Co. Clare V95 K88N.

In accordance with the Habitats Directive, Appropriate Assessment Screening has been carried out on the project. An Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) screening determination has been made and concludes that there is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed development and as such an EIA is not required. Any person may, within 4 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.

This development proposes works to a Protected Structure (RPS No.: 736 / NIAH No.: 2000141 as noted in the Clare County Development Plan 2023-2029 Volume 4) and that is part of a National Monument (No.170 / RMP CL033-082001 - Ennis Friary Complex).
