8. Curtha faoi bhráid na Comhairle ag Cllr. P.J. Kelly:-

“That Clare County Council would provide grant aid to community groups who wish to enhance existing leisure facilities by providing low cost toilet facilities.”

“I request that Clare County Council agree to write to all our Tidy Towns committees within Co Clare area thanking them for their invaluable work within their communities. These volunteers have been keeping their street and roads litter and weed free, planting shrubs, bulbs and flowers, dealing with dumping & graffiti and ensuring their town or village looks its very best each year.”

With the increase in popularity of sea swimming and other water sports, there is now a need for lifeguards everyday at the most popular beaches during the month of June."

13. Curtha faoi bhráid na Comhairle ag Cllr. G. Flynn:-

“I am requesting information from Clare County Council covering the different measures used in Clare to address the housing crisis during the years 2019/2020&2021. What is required is an accurate assessment of the demand from the public for housing support and the methodology been applied in Clare as a response and the effects of the measures on addressing the serious issue for those in need of a home.

1/ How many applications were received and approved by the housing section covering 2019/2020&2021.

2/ How many Tenancies were allocated and signed up by the housing section for 2019/2020&2021.

3/ How many Tenancies were allocated using Choice Based Letting (CBL)during 2019/2020&2021 and how many tenancies were allocated for the same period using the more traditional method of assessment of all approved applicants for consideration in respects to suitable and available housing.

4/ How many Home Loan Applications were made during 2019/2020 &2021 and how many loans were approved and drawn down.

5/ How many approved applicants were removed from The Housing Support List as a result of the review process carried out by the local authority during 2019/2020&2021.

The overall information I am requesting needs to focus entirely on the measures specifically applied by Clare County Council and outside of approved housing bodies, housing assistance payments and leasing of accommodation as this will provide more transparency on how best to adjudicate on the effectiveness of the policy in place.”
