# Minutes of Annual Meeting of West Clare Municipal District held on 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2018 at 12.00 p.m. in Kilrush MD offices

Cllr. Hillery welcomed everyone to the meeting. He thanked the members for their support during the past 12 months indicating that it had been an honour for him to serve as Cathaoirleach of the Municipal District of West Clare. He indicated that a lot had happened in the West Clare Municipal District over the past 12 months with the provision of Hubs in Kilrush & Miltown Malbay, he referred to the Part VIII planning for Blakes Corner being approved, the provision of new toilet facilities at the beaches in Spanish Point & Lahinch, the retention of 9 Blue Flags .He also welcomed the fact that it was proposed to construct 18 Local Authority houses in Quilty.

He acknowledged the staff of Clare County Council for their support during the past year especially John Corry, Leonard Cleary, John O' Malley, Morgan Lahiffe, & all the overseers & general operatives. He wished the incoming Cathaoirleach the very best in the role. He also thanked the Press & in particular Peter O' Connell of the Clare Champion.

The members and executive thanked Cllr. Hillery and complimented him on his leadership over the past year.

# 1. Election of Cathaoirleach for 12 months

Cllr. Curtin proposed Cllr. Lynch for the position of Cathaoirleach. This was seconded by Cllr. Kelly. There were no other nominations & Cllr. Lynch was deemed elected.

Cllr. Lynch thanked the members for proposing him as Cathaoirleach. He said it was a great honour. He indicated that communities were the lifeblood of the West Clare MD. He stressed the importance of effective communication within Clare Co Council to maximize its efficiency. He added that it was his intention that the MD meetings would be very progressive.

The members all wished Cllr. Lynch well in his role as Cathaoirleach.

# 2. Election of Leas Cathaoirleach for 12 months

Cllr. Keating was proposed by Cllr. Curtin for the position of Leas Cathaoirleach and was seconded by Cllr. Kelly. As there were no other nominations, Cllr. Keating was elected to the position. All members wished Cllr. Keating well in his role as Leas Cathaoirleach.

He also advised that at a future date that he would like to Brief Members on the Cliffs of Moher, which was presently going through a lot of change. The members welcomed this & indicated that the challenges facing the Cliffs of Moher should be viewed as something positive which provided opportunities.

#### 3. Approval to payment of Allowance to Cathaoirleach of Municipal District

The approval to the payment of an allowance to the Cathaoirleach of the MD of  $\in 6,000$  was proposed by Cllr. Hillery and seconded by Cllr. Curtin.
